





# INTERNATIONAL REPORT by Joe Mazzone, IAAI-CFI



IAAI membership worldwide was 8935 when last reported. We are hoping to crack the 9000 benchmark very soon. In the Illinois Chapter, membership in the International is required to be an active member (vote or hold office) in the chapter. Many other states do not have this requirement. If you are not yet a member of the International, go to the website and check out the Benefits of Membership section.

#### Other International news items:

- Check out the two new modules on CFItrainer.net, Introduction to Youth Set Fires and Legal Aspects of Youth Set Fires.
- IAAI-CFI certifications have passed the 2100 plateau. The CFI program was designed and activated as an Illinois Chapter function. It was quickly adopted practically verbatim by the International. Illinois was also the first state to begin testing at Chapter seminars.
- 24 Chapters, including Illinois, participate in the Enhanced Chapter program. Six additional chapters have expressed interest.
- The Expert Witness Courtroom Testimony class is being revamped, as it is every few years. Stay tuned if you need this prerequisite for your CFI certification.
- An 8-hour Report Writing class is in the works.
- The Editorial Review Committee is making some changes to facilitate and speed up the process by which articles are published in the Fire & Arson Investigator.
- Director Randy Watson reports that the 2017 Edition of NFPA 921 should be out by the end of this year

Incendiary fires and insurance policies are inexorably linked. Any investigation of an incendiary fire should also include a close look at the insurance policy involved.

In an (April 2009) Insurance Angle article, Attorney Rick Hammond wrote about the growing issues facing insurance companies when faced with claims not from insureds but from mortgage companies.

These issues are continuing to cause problems for insurance companies. "Friction Fires" i.e. the mortgage rubbing up against the insurance policy, seem to be a more and more common claim. As Mr. Hammond said "It is safe to say that experience has taught some insurance companies that, when property owners become financially unable to take care of their secured obligations, or become so neglectful of their obligations that foreclosure must be resorted to, the likelihood of fire becomes greater".

Sometimes the insured has abandoned the property and it is actually the mortgage company making a claim. Many insurance policies contain a Mortgage Clause which states something to the effect of, in the advent of a claim the mortgage company will be named on any payments and if a claim is denied, that denial shall not apply to a valid claim of the mortgagee. Adding another layer of uncertainty to these claims is that mortgage companies often hire mortgage servicing companies to present their claims. (It would be interesting to look into whether these companies are complying with IL Statutes regarding public adjusting firms?)

Trends seem to indicate that mortgage companies and mortgage servicing companies are becoming more aggressive in their presentation of claims and filing of suits. It is important to note that in order for a mortgage company to submit a successful claim under the mortgage clause of a policy there are conditions with which they must comply. These usually include notifying the insurance company of any change in risk. This would include initiation of a foreclosure action, or vacancy. The mortgage company is also usually required to file a Proof of Loss. In a recent claim the mortgage company's claim was successfully denied when the investigation of the claim learned that they were aware the insured had vacated the property and did not notify the insurance company. In fact the mortgage company had hired a maintenance company to cut the grass which had grown several feet high.

In cases of foreclosure, if the foreclosure took place after the date of loss, the mortgagee may no longer have an insurable interest and therefore not have a standing to present an insurance claim. Foreclosure documents can be requested from the mortgage company and also may be available at the county circuit clerk's office. A title search may be helpful in determining insurable interest and can be requested for a nominal fee from a title company.

These claims can be complex, but it is important that insurance companies fully investigate these claims. When anyone intentionally starts a fire for the purpose of obtaining insurance benefits it is a particularly heinous act. They are placing their own pecuniary interests above the safety of firefighters and the general public



A complete list of serial numbers included in this recall is on the firm's website. The mowers are green and yellow with yellow wheels. The model number is on the front of the machine, near the operator footrest. The serial number is located behind the seat, in front of the engine. Incidents/Injuries

#### No incidents or injuries have been reported.
